Have you heard of the RHS cookbook? It's filled with delightful recipes that will enhance your holiday season. In this segment, we are sharing a recipe we hope you add to your dinner table.


AUNT EDNA'S CHRISTMAS CAKE

INGREDIENTS

- 3 large apples, peeled and sliced
- 1 cup chocolate chips, divided
- 1 cup chopped nuts, divided
- 2 1/2 cups all-purpose flour, divided
- 1/2 cup shortening
- 1 1/4 cups firmly packed brown sugar, divided
- 3/4 cup granulated sugar
- 2 large eggs
- 1 teaspoon baking powder
- 1 teaspoon baking soda
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 1 cup cold water
- 1 teaspoon vanilla

DIRECTIONS

1. Preheat the oven to 350 degrees. Grease a 13 X 9-inch baking pan. Set aside.
2. In a medium bowl, combine the apples, 1/2 cup of the chocolate chips, 1/2 cup of the chopped nuts, and 1/2 cup of the flour. Toss together to coat the mixture and set aside.
3. In a large bowl, cream the shortening, 3/4 cup of the brown sugar, the granulated sugar, and the eggs. Add the remaining 2 cups of the flour, the baking powder, baking soda, and salt alternatively with the cold water and vanilla. Mix well. Fold in the apple mixture. Spread into the prepared pan.
4. In a small bowl, mix the remaining 1/2 cup of brown sugar, the remaining 1/2 cup of chocolate chips, and the remaining 1/2 cup of nuts together and sprinkle on top of the batter. Bake for 30 to 45 minutes, or until a toothpick inserted in the center comes out clean.
